Summer Inquiry Is Underway

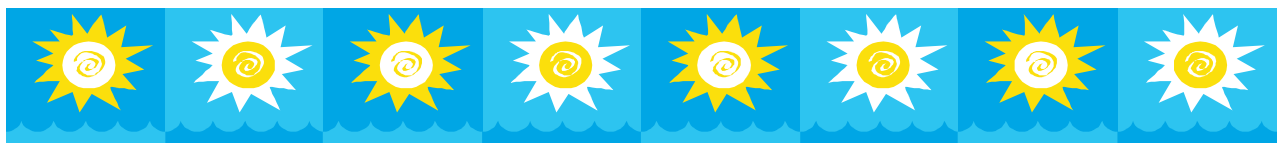

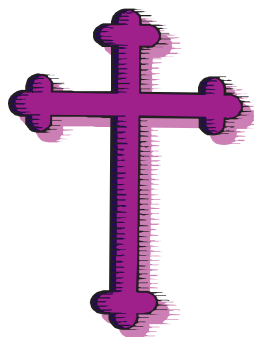
